Kris Lundberg is proud to be a 3rd generation active UAW member who originally started at General Motors in Flint, MI, where she became a member of UAW Local 651. Like many others she became a "GM Gypsy", spending time in Pontiac, MI, before transferring in 1991 to Martinsburg, WV, where she spent 20 years as a member of Local 1590...Kris was active in all three UAW Locals, and during her time in Martinsburg, Kris had the opportunity to serve in many different elected and appointed capacities, including Executive Board positions and the communication roles of webmaster and the editor of her local's newspaper.

She has had the opportunity for many unique experiences, including being appointed by then Region 8 Director Gary Casteel as the 2006 Fellow for the Region, and as a member of the Constitution Committee at the 2006 International UAW Constitutional Convention. She has also worked as UAW Release Staff for the CAP Department, Organizing, and the Education Department, where in 2012 she became a national trainer for the 99% Spring program.

In January 2011, then Vice President Joe Ashton appointed Kris as Special Assigned to the Training Department at the UAW-GM Center for Human Resources in Detroit, and in February 2013 she was appointed by UAW President Bob King as UAW International Staff assigned to the UAW-General Motors Benefits Department.

In 2014 she was appointed by President King to the initial UAW PRO-Member team and was transferred to the UAW Woman's Department until 2016, when UAW President Dennis Williams returned her to the UAW-GM Department. In January 2018, Kris returned to UAW Region 8, where she currently serves as the political coordinator and Retired Workers representative for the southern half of the Region, and as the liaison for the Region to the UAW Women's Department. She is a member of the NAACP and CLUW.
